

2023-2024 School Uniform Policy-Girls

Middle School 7th-8th Grade

7th Grade: Casual ACA gear may be worn once per week, day TBD



3 days a week Daily Dress Attire

Dress Shirts:

- Dress shirts in any color, plaid, stripes, or pattern may be worn – loose fitting only; no thin tank tops; no low-cut front or back
- No bra straps or bralettes can show at any time
- Must be free of graphics, cartoons, and ads (small logos ok)
- No puffy vests. Dressy or nice jean vests ok
- NO (non-ACA) sweatshirts or t-shirts (short sleeved or long sleeved) of any kind

Dresses/Skirts/Skorts:

- If worn with leggings, dresses/skirts must be fingertip length or longer.
- All dresses/skirts must be non-form fitting (length must be 1" above the knee or longer if worn with bike shorts or tights)
- Tights, leggings, or bike shorts must be worn under skirts at all times
- Loose fitting t-shirt style dresses may be worn
 ONLY if accompanied by a sweater/vest/jacket over

Pants & Dress Shorts:

- Loose fitting dress pants in any color, pattern that are non-form fitting (no athletic pants/shorts, corduroy, cargo pants, jeans/denim, or PJ pants)
- Dress Shorts must be no shorter than 3" above the knee and be non-form fitting

Shoes and Socks:

- Appropriate coordinating clean dress/casual shoes w/ coordinating socks/tights. No UGG style boots
- No open toed shoes or platforms of any kind
- 2" or less heels/wedges are acceptable (no crocs)
 Sweaters & Cardigans & Nice Jean Jackets

• May be worn with daily dress

School Logoed Hooded Sweatshirts:

• School logoed sweatshirt ONLY in navy or grey

1 day a week (Wednesdays ONLY) Performance Dress Attire

Shirts:

 Lands' End school uniform <u>OXFORD</u> light blue or white shirt (long or short sleeve) ONLY; loose fitting

Skirts:

- Lands' End school uniform plaid skirt in the CLASSIC NAVY PLAID (length must be 1" above the knee or longer) *skirts offered in "below the knee" styles are best for middle school
- If worn with leggings, dresses/skirts may be fingertip length or longer
- No jumpers allowed in middle school

<u>Sweaters:</u>

- Sweaters and cardigans may be worn in solid navy, grey, white, or tan/brown ONLY
- No sweatshirts of any kind are allowed

<u>Tights/Knee Socks/Leggings:</u>

- Navy, grey, black, or white ONLY
- Tights, leggings, or bike shorts must be worn under skirts at all times
- NO over the knee socks are allowed

Shoes/Boots:

- Dress shoes or dress-boots in brown, black, navy, tan or grey ONLY
- No open toed shoes or platforms of any kind
- 2" or less heels/wedges are acceptable
- No tennis shoes, UGG style boots, or sandals

As applicable Physical Education Attire

To be brought in a separate PE bag & changed into prior to PE **PE clothes MUST be worn on Spirit Days as well

Shirts:

 School Logo PE Shirt- available for purchase at Back-to-School Night and will also be available at the school office following the start of the school year. These are the ONLY shirts allowed to be worn for PE.

Athletic Pants/Shorts:

- Uniform PE pants and shorts will be available for purchase at Back-to-School Night and will also be available at the school office following the start of the school year. These are the ONLY pants/shorts allowed to be worn for PE.
- Shorts MUST be no more than 2" above the knee
- Shorts may NOT be rolled at the waist

Athletic Shoes:

- Clean/gym floor ready tennis shoes MUST be brought to school on PE Days along with PE clothes to wear during the scheduled PE time
- Shoes are to be as plain as possible (white, black, navy or grey are preferred)

Athletic Socks:

 Students MUST bring athletic socks to be worn on PE Days; black, white, or grey ONLY

School Logoed Hooded Sweatshirts:

- May be worn daily, except on Chapel days
- Navy or grey only

Hip Hop & Lyrical Dance Team

Students in Hip Hop &/or Lyrical Dance Team will be given practice dress requirements directly from their teacher

1 day a week (Fridays ONLY) Casual Dress Attire

*may also wear performance dress or daily dress in addition to casual dress

All clothes must fit the modesty policy per our handbook.

<u>Jeans:</u> may be worn on Casual Dress Days: no holes above the knees (unless no skin is showing through) and no holes bigger than a softball (3.5" in diameter)

<u>Sweatshirts/Hoodies:</u> In addition to school gear students may wear a sweatshirt, hoodie, or jacket of your choice as long as it is school appropriate

<u>Pants:</u> Leggings may be worn ONLY with a top/shirt/dress/skirt that reaches to fingertip or longer.

Additional Weekly Dress Requirements

Hair, Hoods & Hats:

- No non-natural hair color allowed
- No hats are allowed to be worn inside; may be worn outside if not distracting
- NO hoods worn inside the building

Modesty:

- No spaghetti straps/thin tank tops (less than 3 fingers width)
- No crop tops; No midriff skin may show at any time; even when arms are raised
- No bra straps or bralettes may show at any time
- NO off the shoulder, open back, or shear/mesh shirts/tops/dresses/etc.

Other:

- Outer wear/jackets will not be allowed to be worn inside the classrooms on any day
- No excessively long fingernails
- No nose rings or other visible body piercings (except ears)
 School Logoed Hooded Sweatshirts may be worn
 any day except Performance Dress days
- SHOES: No open toed shoes, slippers, or platforms of any kind; 2" or less heels/wedges are acceptable
- Crocs OK on Fridays only
- NO Pajama pants may be worn on any day
