PAYMENT METHODS: Kindergarten-12th Grade

ALL accounts are required to have a payment method on file via an ACH agreement, regardless of payment plan.

- **1 Payment:** cash, check, ACH or credit card (3% fee)- *paid in full discounts apply*
- **2 Payments:** cash, check, ACH or credit card (3% fee)
- **10 Payments, July- April:** ACH via a checking or savings account- *includes \$5 monthly processing fee**
- **12 Payments, July-June:** ACH via a checking or savings account- *includes \$5 monthly processing fee**

ENROLLMENT POLICY

- ACA students (K-11) will be continuously enrolled with a fee in February, unless specifically opted-out by January 15th and notification to finance director is received.
- A \$30.00 fee will be applied to your account for any failed auto-debit and/or check payments. You will need to bring your account current within 5 business days of notification from Finance Director
- If tuition is past due at the end of the school year, official transcripts will be withheld and not transferred until the account is brought current. Enrollment for the coming school year will not be offered if there is a delinquent balance on the account.

REFUND & WITHDRAWAL INFORMATION

- In the case of voluntary withdrawal from our program, a prorated tuition amount (if applicable) will be refunded within 60 days of notice of withdrawal.
- Enrollment fees are non-refundable
- There is a \$250 withdrawal fee, per student, for Kindergarten-High School if your student withdraws at any point after enrollment.
- In addition to the withdrawal fee, if it is after June 1st, 10% of the annual tuition amount is non-refundable. This helps cover preplanned, set expenses for the school year, such as insurance, curriculum, and supplies.
